 **ONMISSION**

The COVID-19 coronavirus is sweeping through the US and the world at a rapid pace. In the US, even with our advanced medical systems, we are struggling to cope with the ever changing landscape of the pandemic. It is our prayer that the church will be a blessing in these difficult days.

We appreciate your prayer support for our missionaries and we wanted to give an update with regards to the pandemic and how it is affecting them and their ministries. Please be assured that all of our missionaries are safe and healthy.. They appreciate your ongoing prayers for them and those they serve.

### **Bolivia**

Pray for the Bolivian health care professionals as they deal with the Coronavirus pandemic. As of today, there are 27 cases in the country and there is a government mandated quarantine for 14 days which is severely restricting day to day life in Bolivia. Many families in Bolivia live day to day, they cannot sustain a long period of quarantine and be able to provide for their families.

Pray for the ECAMM students who are quarantined all over Bolivia and in Peru. The ECAMM training that was supposed to start on April 13 has been postponed until August.

Pray for the different classes both for schools and seminary that are planned to be taught using Zoom video conferencing. Most Bolivian's do not have internet in their homes so doing something like this is not what they are used to and could be a struggle for many. Pray for the children who were part of all three

tutoring centers who are simply missing out on education at this time.

Pray for the Canny family as they are preparing to come back to the US for deputation but uncertain of how and when that can happen due to the cancellation of all international flights in and out of Bolivia until at least April 21. Please pray for wisdom as they make decisions for their return to the US.

Pray for the Wolheter's elderly parents back in the US. Jenny's mom is a cancer survivor with a compromised immune system. If they were to become seriously ill, they would not be able to leave the country due to no international flights currently running.

### **Liberia**

Pray for Pastor George, National Superintendent of the Liberia Evangelical Mission who is stuck in the US due to the cancellation of flights serving Liberia with connections from the US. Brussels Air has canceled flights for the next month. Please pray for his wife Hazel who is in Liberia.

Pray for Liberia. It is not equipped for large scale emergencies although it is believed that the country learned some things as a result of the EBOLA epidemic and probably has a good idea of what to do. Pray that there will be no panic. Pray that true believers will keep their heads and their faith centered in Christ.

Pray for the Elliott families as they prepare to come home for deputations, Daniel, Naomi and family are scheduled to come to the US in late July, Gordon, Niki and family in September. Pray that the flights will be operating normally by then and that churches here in the US will be back to normal as well.

### **Southwest U.S.**

Pray for the congregations of both churches in New Mexico as their members are mostly older retired people, the age that is of the most concern for staying healthy. Praise God that the Navajo nation cases have been limited to only two in Arizona and that everyone is using caution and staying at home.

Pray for David and Carol Kochendorfer as they are working to find ways to stay connected with their church family since they are not able to meet for worship or prayer meetings at the church. They are working hard to help those people that they know need extra assistance during this time.
