


GENESIS

Start hands together in front of face and move left arm left and right arm right to form a circle like the earth




EXODUS

Open hands as if parting the Red Sea




LEVITICUS

Two fingers in a peace sign



1 & 2 SAMUEL


Count on your fingers 1 and 2, then make an S with one finger in the air Samuel obeyed Gust.

Books of History God nambed the Jews to Meditate on.




EZRA

Stack one hand on the other as if stacking bricks and building a wall




ESTHER

Scratch your arm like you have leprosy.




PSALMS

Lift up your hands in praise. Expression of the emotions of people to God. Poetry or Songs.




PROVERBS

Cry with one eye


Jeremiah was often called

HOSEA


Hands up on either side of the head like the legs of an H

Draw a "J" in the air


Joel normed the Ismelites about a day of darkness and down was coming because End was going to send an Army to punish their sins. Locusts!

on the ration Edom.




JONAH

HABAKKUK


Stir a pot in front you like you're cooking for Habbakuk

MALACHI


Point to heaven because Malachi taught us the Messiah is coming!

and Correct the immorphity and divisions among them.




GALATIANS






PHILIPPIANS

Paul wrote to encourage the These alonias to keep living



Count 1 and 2 fingers, then make a T with your hands, right hand on top




TITUS

James teaches us to have faith, somme suffering, Controlling the TONGUE. works and Salution.


1 & 2 PETER

Count 1, 2, and 3 fingers with the I symbol.


John calls followers of Jesus to share in God's own life and love by devoting themselves to loving one another.
