3. David trusted Joab to murder for him, but he didn't trust Uriah to forgive him. Why do people believe that one more lie will be enough for them to "get away" with their sin? Why is it hard to believe that people will forgive your worst sins?

Closing Question: Read 2 Samuel 12:1-14

Why do you think David was so quick to get angry about the story Nathan told him, but wasn't broken about his own sin?
