 - What are the two results of Scriptures in our lives?
- 5. Have someone read this important statement from our church leadership concerning this class "There will be a lot of information that you will learn over the next several months. Some of the information will be life-changing because you've never heard something taught quite like this before. However, there may be other moments in this class when you struggle keeping up or don't understand a concept or teaching. During those moments, please focus on what you understand and not what you don't. Understanding the Scriptures is a lifetime of study, not an instant grasping of every truth. Be patient with yourself. Ask God for help when you don't understand. Most of all, don't quit learning. These classes are meant to provide a greater knowledge of God that leads you to know and love Him more."
