## **Pre-Video Discussion Questions**

## Review from last session...

- 1. Review the promises made to Abraham by God in Genesis 12:1-3.
- 2. How is Genesis 12:1-3 an expansion of God's promises to Adam and Eve in Genesis 3:15? (Compare Genesis 12:3 and Galatians 3:8)
- 3. Is Genesis 12:1-3 a conditional or an unconditional promise? If it is an unconditional promise, what does that mean regarding Abraham's behavior along the way?
- 4. Briefly discuss Abraham's belief being counted as righteousness in Genesis 15:6. If you have time, discuss God's expression of this unconditional promise in Genesis 15.

## **Post-Video Discussion Questions**

- 1. What does the name *Jacob* mean? Along with your group, briefly discuss the deceit of Jacob concerning his brother, Esau (Genesis 25:29-34; Genesis 27:1-13).
- 2. Explain the significance of Jacob wrestling with God in Genesis 32:22-30.
- 3. How does Jacob "overcome"? (see three things in notes)
- 4. Why would God call Himself the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob...especially considering the character of Jacob?
