Pre-Video Discussion Questions

Today, we'll be talking about escape and one of the names of God so here are some questions to get us thinking in that direction.

- 1. Is there any backstory on your name (first or middle); in other words, do you know why you have the names you do?
- 2. Do you have a story to share about a time when you have escaped from something scary or have barely got out of a fearful situation?
- 3. Review the meaning of Genesis 3:15.
- 4. Review the promises God made to Abraham in Genesis 12:1-3.

Post-Video Discussion Questions

- 1. Work with your group to explain how the book of Exodus relates to the book of Genesis, especially the continuation of God's promise to Abraham.
- 2. Develop 2-3 sentences with your group that more fully explain the meaning of the name *Yahweh* and then connect this name of God with His covenant with Abraham.
- 3. Explain how the plagues demonstrate who Yahweh is in relation to Egyptian theology.
- 4. Along with your group, write out a brief paragraph explaining the meaning of the Passover.
