- 2. In the book of Leviticus, how did God express His personal relationship with Israel?
- 3. When we review the promises God made to Abraham, which on the following has NOT been accomplished?
 - Remove the people from Egyptian slavery
 - Make Israel into a nation
 - Dwell in relationship and presence with Israel
 - Israel inherits the land
- 4. In your opinion, what should happen in the next part of this story? Why?
