Pre-Video Discussion Questions

Let's review, especially since we are picking back up the narrative from Exodus (Leviticus didn't advance the story very far).

1. Review briefly these happenings in the book of Exodus...
 - Israel had been delivered from the most powerful nation on the planet a month ago
 - Israel walked through the middle of the Red Sea
 - Israel had been constituted into a new, special nation
2. In the book of Leviticus, how did God express His personal relationship with Israel?
3. When we review the promises God made to Abraham, which on the following has NOT been accomplished?
 - Remove the people from Egyptian slavery
 - Make Israel into a nation
 - Dwell in relationship and presence with Israel
 - Israel inherits the land
4. In your opinion, what should happen in the next part of this story? Why?

1. What phrase is continually used in Numbers 1-9?
2. Have someone read Numbers 9:15-19. What was the function of the pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night?
3. Regarding the book of Numbers, how does human responsibility influence or affect God's sovereignty?
4. Regarding the book of Numbers, how does my foolishness or my faithfulness affect God's plan for my life?
