 - a. The universality of spiritual gifts: "to each one." These come with conversion, as standard equipment in every believer's life.
 - b. The definition of spiritual gifts: "the manifestation of the Spirit."
 - c. The nature of spiritual gifts: "is given." Spiritual gifts are given, not earned.
 - d. The purpose of spiritual gifts: "for the common good." They are given not to puff up ourselves, but to build up the body.
- 2. Discuss how a person might determine their spiritual giftings? (Dr. Kimble mentions four ways)
- 3. Why doesn't having the Holy Spirit guarantee that I'll always rightly interpret the Bible?
