Pre-Video Discussion Questions

1. Have someone read the following verses: Romans 12:6-6; 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, 28-30; Ephesians 4:11. Write down all the spiritual gifts listed in these verses.
2. Based on the list of spiritual gifts your group has compiled, which ones do you possess?
3. What is the importance of spiritual gifts according to 1 Peter 4:10-11?

Post-Video Discussion Questions

1. Discuss each of the four important truths about spiritual gifts according to 1 Corinthians 12:7...
 - a. The universality of spiritual gifts: “to each one.” These come with conversion, as standard equipment in every believer’s life.
 - b. The definition of spiritual gifts: “the manifestation of the Spirit.”
 - c. The nature of spiritual gifts: “is given.” Spiritual gifts are given, not earned.
 - d. The purpose of spiritual gifts: “for the common good.” They are given not to puff up ourselves, but to build up the body.
2. Discuss how a person might determine their spiritual giftings? (Dr. Kimble mentions four ways)
3. Why doesn’t having the Holy Spirit guarantee that I’ll always rightly interpret the Bible?
