Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA)

When a child enters the foster care system because his or her home is no longer safe due to abuse or neglect, a judge may appoint a community member, a volunteer, dedicated to advocate for the best interest of the child in court and other settings. That volunteer is called a Court Appointed Special Advocate, or CASA. The Golden Crescent CASA organization provides support to CASA volunteers and provides volunteer trainings in the community to assure every foster child has a trained, constant, and committed adult to advocate for the child's best interests and will assist in finding the child a nurturing and permanent home.
