## JOSEPH'S STORY CONTINUES ...

(GENESIS 39-50)

- After Joseph was sold into slavery he was taken to Egypt. He met Potiphar an officer of Pharaoh. [Gen. 39:1]
- The Lord was with Joseph. He became a successful man and he was in the house of his Egyptian master. [Gen. 39:2]
- Joseph's master saw that the Lord was with Joseph and everything he did was successful. Joseph became overseer of Pharaoh's house and the Lord blessed the house for Joseph's sake. [Gen. 39:3-6]
- Then, Joseph went to prison because Potiphar's wife accused Joseph of laying with her but he didn't. God was with him and Joseph gained favor with the keeper of the prison. [Gen. 39:6-23]
- After Joseph was in prison for 2 years, Pharaoh had troubling dreams that no one else could interpret but Joseph. Joseph interpreted the dreams and Pharaoh put him back in charge over the house of Egypt! [Gen. 41]
- Joseph was now 30 and he interpreted a dream Pharaoh had about an awful famine in the land that lasted 7 years. This famine affected everyone even Joseph's family back home... [Gen. 41:46-56]
- 7 Joseph's brothers came to Egypt to buy food due to the famine.
  The brothers didn't recognise Joseph. Joseph revealed himself to his brothers, forgave them for what they did to him and provided them with food.. [Gen. 43-46]
- The famine was over and God had used Joseph to save all the people of Egypt & his family. What Joseph's brothers meant for evil, God meant for good to save the lives of many! [Gen. 46-50]
