 - Do you often find it hard to actually follow through and discipline your children?
 - How can we discipline out of love instead of anger?
 - Why should we as adults set clear boundaries, communicate logical consequences, and actually follow through?
- Practically, how can you incorporate and model a Godly lifestyle regularly for your kids or the kids in your life? Remember, kids value fun and need consistency!

Read Psalm 127:3-5 out loud. Take turns praying for your children by name and if you don't have children of your own, ask the Lord for opportunities to show Christ's love to other kids.
