Mary has just given birth to Jesus, He was circumcised after the 8<sup>th</sup> day and now 40 days later, they were permitted to bring Him to the temple in Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord, as it was written in the Law. There they meet a man named Simeon who had been informed by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Messiah. So on this particular day he was led by the Spirit to go to the temple and at that moment, in walks Mary and Joseph holding baby Jesus. Luke 2:28-35

At the same time Anna the prophetess who had been studying Old Testament scripture and teaching about the redemption of God's people also sees this encounter and testifies of the Lord's faithfulness.

-Absolute fast: Consists of no food or drink. Acts 9:9 tells us Paul did not eat or drink for 3 days.

Jesus abstained from food he still drank water.

-Partial fast: This is the restriction of diet. In Daniel 10:3 we see Daniel abstaining from eating the kings delicacies (meat) for 3 weeks. This could also be laying aside a whole meal for a period of time also known as "skipping a meal."

Anna's Consolation: Luke 2:38  As Anna had remained committed to her calling, trusting God to take care of her, one day she happened to see the Messiah that God had promised in the Old Testament readings. I imagine when she saw and heard the joy of Simeon that her heart was comforted. In response to this peace and comfort of knowing everything was going to be okay she:
*Gave God; What does it mean to give thanks to someone? Psalm 136
*She of Him; What are your thought on talking to others about the Lord Especially those who are looking for help and hope? Psalm 107:1-2
