When Adam God it caused all of mankind to sin and make us His enemies. Jesus came to His life and thus restore our relationship with God.  Romans 5:12; 18	
As the story of mankind continues, the Bible teaches us that because of Adam's disobedience to God, sin and death <i>reigned</i> from Adam to Moses. Romans 5:13	
This was a total of generations. (Adam, Seth, Methuselah, Lemech, Noah, Shem, Eber/Heber, Terah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Levi, and Moses)	
In establishing the law through Moses, God required a blood sacrifice be made from animals without spot or blemish. Every year the Hebrew priests would make these	

sacrifices and think about the future when God would provide a Savior to take away sin once and for all. Leviticus 16:15-16; 22:20; Hebrews 9:14 Jesus in the Old Testament: Savior of mankind; Genesis 3:15; This is what is known as a *protoevangelium* " gospel" because it is the Bible's first prophecy of a Savior. First; "he will crush your head"; That is the seed of the woman will crush the serpent's head. Second; "you will strike his head."; That is, the serpent will bite the heal of the women's seed. Cross Reference: Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:25; Galatians 4:4 Tribe of His birth; Genesis 49:10; Worldly authority was symbolized by the scepter. Although this was a temporary matter for kings of this day, the Holy Spirit was pointing them/us to Jesus as the one whom all nations will honor. Some translations say, until Shiloh comes. Shiloh is also a title of M Cross Reference: 2 Samuel 7:8-16; Luke 1:31-33 Nation of His birth; Numbers 24:17; Balaam was a true prophet through whom the Lord spoke, but his heart was wicked. In this verse he prophesied of Jesus as a star and scepter. The images of the star and scepter speak of the Messiah's \_\_\_\_ and reign. Cross Reference: Matthew 1:1-17 City of His birth; Micah 5:2-5; In this prophecy Micah revealed the following facts about the Messiah: \*He is E \_\_\_\_\_

Origin of His birth; Isaiah 7:14; Since Ahaz refused to give a sign, the Lord provided His own. This prophecy reached forward to the virgin birth of the Messiah. The word virgin means "\_\_\_\_\_\_ woman"

What is the teaching/belief of the virgin birth and why is it so important?

Origin of His nature; Isaiah 9:6; This prophecy not only speaks to the <u>human</u> of the Messiah, but also His <u>deity</u> .
Cross Reference: John 1:14
Notice the different names/titles and what they tell us about Jesus.
*Immanuel: God with us (Isaiah 7:14)  *Wonderful Counselor: He has the wisdom to justly.  *Mighty God: He has the to execute His wise plans.  *Everlasting Father: He is the originator of eternity.  *Prince of Peace: He is the mediator who promotes peace between us and God/fellow mankind.

In looking at these prophecies in the Old Testament that were spoken and fulfi how does this help your confidence in knowing God and His Word?
