## **Salvation in the New Testament:**

In the New Testament salvation is obtained by \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ alone through **faith** in the person and work of Jesus Christ. In the gospel according to John, he sates in chapter 1:1-2 "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning." At the conclusion of verse 14 we see, just like God initiated salvation in the Old Testament through obedience to His Word (Law), He now provides a fulfillment of salvation by way of His love (Grace). Instead of sacrificing animals over and over again, He establishes a new covenant and allows humanity the free will to accept the permanent sacrifice, shed blood, and atonement of our sin once and for all, in His Son Jesus Christ.
