*Tartarus 2 Peter 2:4; Unlike Hades, Gehenna, or Hell Tartarus is a place where certain angels are contained.

*Lake of _____ Revelation 20:13-15; After the final judgement, all those whose names are not written in the Lamb’s book of life will be cast into the Lake of fire. This is the _____ death.

*Sheol. A bonus word for grave and death. Hebrew word widely translated in various forms such as hell, in the earth, grave, or pit. It is known as a place in which one is held captive in darkness and silence. Psalm 18:5; 88:6; 115:17
