#2 With Conviction: James 5:17b and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and for three years and six months it did not.

Like confidence, whenever someone has a strong conviction about a particular matter they will <u>stand firm</u> and will not be moved regardless of what anyone else says or does. In this case it is a strong internal belief in God, His word and His will.
