• Overcome/Remove Obstacles: Mark 11:20-25

This text is a reflection of the barrenness of the nation of Israel. Normally if a fig tree had leaves it meant it had fruit. From a distance, metaphorically speaking, the nation's spiritual leaders had an outward look as if they believed and followed God, but as Jesus got closer, there was nothing. Therefore, he cursed the tree as judgement upon Israel and a warning to us.

Remember: God is not pleased when His people are all leaves and no fruit!

Jesus is saying, just like I have the power to say that this fig tree will no longer produce fruit or anything, you too have access to the power. This access is having faith in God to do the same for us in prayer, even if it seems impossible.

In order to do this we must understand the following:

#1 God is the object of our Faith: Mark 11:20-22; Romans 3:21-22			
We must trust in the right			
#2 Faith in God gives us authority to speak directly to the obstacles of life: Mark 11:23			
The phrase "This mountain" was a popular figure of speech for any insurmountable problem.

#3 Faith in God must be sure: Mark 11:24-25			
*Prayer gives us to power. *Believe in advance, according to God's will. *Unrepentant sin blocks our request.			
• Forgive of Sin: Mark 2:1-12			
Mark talks about an occasion when Jesus was speaking and the crowds were so much there was no way for people to get to him. However, there was a paralytic man who had four friends who tore a hole in the roof/ceiling, lowered him in front of Jesus so that He might heal the man.
