The invitation to the Un-invited: 8-13
After the king was <u>rejected</u> by those he invited and took <u>revenge</u> on those who killed his servants, verse 9 says he sent servants to go where the roads exit the city and invite to the banquet.
The servants did just that gathering both and As a result, the wedding banquet was filled with guests.
Who do you think the Un-invited guest represent? Why?
Some writers believe this is a picture of the millennial reign of Christ referred to in Revelation 20:2-7. This will be a time when Satan will be bound for years and will no longer be able to deceive the nations. The dead in Christ will rise and those who remain alive, both <u>evil</u> and <u>good</u> will be free to come to Christ.

Getting back to the parable, Jesus said, when the king came in to see all of the guest, he saw a man there who was not dressed for a wedding. Some translations say, he did not have on a wedding *garment*.

Can you imagine someone showing up for your wedding or event in something totally different from what you asked them to wear? How would that make you feel?

Fo put in perspective, all who attended the wedding banquet, (evil and good) were expected to put on the garments that the king supplied. So when this man showe
up without his wedding garments he was the kings request.
