



# TRUE NORTH SERVICE SAFETY GUIDELINES

## What we're doing to help you stay healthy...

**Registration and Distancing** -- Due to reduced seating, advance registration for services is required. Distancing guidelines will be in place, wherever possible, and include exceedingly reduced capacities in all aspects of facility usage.

**Temperature Checks** -- We will temperature check all entrants to services as well as team members and staff before serving. Any person with a temperature above 100.4 will not be permitted to serve or attend service that day.

**Sanitization** -- All high-volume areas will be thoroughly sanitized. Restrooms will be available and frequently sanitized between uses. Hand-sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the building.

**Outdoor space** -- We will utilize front parking lot as an extension of the Hub before and after services to alleviate any gathering in the foyer area.

**Miscellaneous** -- Masks will be available on-site upon request. All on-seat materials, papers, and pens will be removed. All resources will be made available online.

## How can you help...

In the last 14 days, if you have been experiencing symptoms of a cough, runny nose, shortness of breath, fever, or if you have had in-person contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, please do not attend an in-person service and plan to worship with us online instead.

If you have a serious underlying medical condition or believe you are in a high-risk category, please continue worshipping with us online.

Wash your hands and use hand sanitizer.

If you have registered for a service and are attending, please maintain distance between yourself and other guests when possible.
