## Old Testament Lesson

#### Micah 5:2-5a

[2] But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose origin is from of old, from ancient days. [3] Therefore he shall give them up until the time when she who is in labor has given birth; then the rest of his brothers shall return to the people of Israel. [4] And he shall stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the Lord, in the majesty of the name of the Lord his God. And they shall dwell secure, for now he shall be great to the ends of the earth. [5] And he shall be their peace.

Micah sees another shepherd-king like David coming from David's town, Bethlehem. This king, however, will be greater. He will deliver his people after a time of suffering and then will nourish them and make them secure with power that is recognized throughout the world.

# Cpistle Reading Hebrews 10:5-10

[5] Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said, "Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me; [6] in burnt offerings and sin offerings you have taken no pleasure. [7] Then I said, 'Behold, I have come to do your will, O God, as it is written of me in the scroll of the book." [8] When he said above, "You have neither desired nor taken pleasure in sacrifices and offerings and burnt offerings and sin offerings" (these are offered according to the law), [9] then he added, "Behold, I have come to do your will." He abolishes the first in order to establish the second. [10] And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

Jesus Christ saved and strengthened (sanctified) his people by abolishing the old covenant of sacrifices and offerings by offering his own body. His supreme sacrifice opened the way for the emergence of a totally new kind of people – men and women who are set apart for God and serve God day and night.

St. Luke 1:39-56



The Word of God teaches that the bread and wine of the Sacrament are the true Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. 
