1. How does God's providence serve to comfort and encourage the believer? What challenges does the doctrine of God's providence bring up?
2. What does it mean that God providence rules over the circumstances of our life and times? How was this seen in Joseph's life? How have you seen this in your own life?
3. Why is it so difficult for us to accept that God's providence rules over the evil actions and intentions of others? Does this make God guilty of sin (James 1:13-14)? Why or why not?
4. How should God's providence over evil and sin be a comfort to us? How can the truth of God's providence over all things increase our faith?
5. How does the cross of Jesus show us the compatibility of God's sovereignty over all things and human responsibility for sin (see Acts 2:22-23; 4:27-28)?
