



The 2020/2021 Reading Plan for the Daily Office and Weekly Lectionary

This unique guide combines two of the traditional and ancient reading plans of the church. I know of no other reading plan that puts these two together in one easy to use Bible reading guide.

The church calendar begins every year at Advent as we join together in hopeful expectation for the coming of Christ. It then follows the life of Jesus through his birth (the seasons of Christmas and Epiphany), his ministry, and finally his death and resurrection (the seasons of Lent and Easter). Easter season ends with Pentecost Sunday. The rest of the year is designated as "Ordinary Time", which continues until the beginning of the next Advent.

Each daily reading consists of significant readings from the Psalms, an Old Testament

reading, a New Testament reading, and a reading from one of the Gospels. Every day you will be immersed in worship. You will gain a greater understanding of both the Testaments. You will mediate daily on the life of Jesus. I love the balance of this plan because it daily helps me focus on Jesus, on worship, and on God's wonderful plan of redemption.

This reading guide has also blessed my life as I journal my of journaling my meditations, prayers, and reflections. Palm Sunday celebrates the triumph of the ministry of Jesus Christ where he is welcomed as the King. Maundy Thursday is the remembrance of the institution of the Lord's Supper. This memorial feast, which represents the sacrifice of the body and

blood of Jesus, is to be celebrated until he comes back again. Jesus is our Passover Lamb. Good Friday is the solemn remembrance of Jesus' death on the cross. He died in our place and took upon himself our burden of sin.
