THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Our Savior experienced the ultimate brokenness that we might experience genuine redemption. Over the last five weeks, we have looked at stories of brokenness that ended in redemption. Thus, we have entitled this series, "Beautifully Broken." Let's take a quick look back to remind ourselves of our Journey.

We began with the life of Moses, who in a moment of anger, murdered another individual. This act led him to forty years of hiding out, avoiding the consequences of his sin. However, what he thought was a season of exile ultimately was season of preparation. After the forty years passed, God called him to lead the people out of slavery in Israel.

Next, we looked at the story of Joseph. He was sold into slavery by his brothers and seemingly forgotten by all who mattered. If that was not enough, he was falsely accused of rape and imprisoned. While in prison, he meets and helps a young man that we only know as the cupbearer to the king. He asked this man to help him out when he had the opportunity, but once again, Joseph was forgotten. What seemed like a season of total isolation and difficulty was actually a time when God was preparing him to lead in amazing ways.

From there we looked at the stories of Ruth and Naomi. Both of these ladies were widows who lost multiple loved ones and were at the mercy of those around them. What seemed like a devastating situation was actually God setting up an amazing story of devotion, commitment, and provision. Because of Ruth's faithfulness, she appears in the genealogy of Jesus Christ.

In the New Testament, we looked at the story of Peter, an impassioned individual who thought he was ready to go to the death with Jesus Christ. Instead, at the first opportunity, he denied that he ever knew Him. What seemed like an insurmountable failure, actually prepared Peter to strengthen those people around him.

Last week we looked at the story of the woman at the well. This lady was so sin scarred that she avoided other people at all cost. However, she met Jesus Christ, and everything changed. Jesus called out her sin and showed her what redemption looked like. As a result, she shared the love of Christ with many others.


