We are quickly approaching Holy Week. This is the week that we set aside to remember our Lord's death, burial, and resurrection, as well as His journey to the cross. Each year at this time I try to remind myself to be prayerful and reflective. Though I cannot fully absorb all that our Lord has done for us, I do want to give it deep consideration. I would hope that you might do the same.

As we think about Holy Week, here is our best understanding of the timeline from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday:

Palm Sunday - Jesus enters into Jerusalem. The crowds hail him as the coming King. He goes to the Temple and looks around. Ultimately, Jesus retires back to Bethany (most

likely to the home of Lazarus, Mary, and Martha). It seems that each evening, Jesus and his disciples would head back to Bethany, away from the city.

Monday - Jesus returns to Jerusalem from Bethany and curses a fig tree on the way. Once in Jerusalem, Jesus cleanses the Temple, driving out all who bought and sold there.

Tuesday – The disciples notice that the fig tree Jesus cursed has died. Jesus uses that as a teaching point. Jesus also spends the day being challenged by the leaders of the day. Jesus also gives the Olivet Discourse on Tuesday.

Wednesday - This is widely regarded as a day of rest for Jesus. It seems that He stayed at the home of Lazarus, Mary, and Martha throughout the day.

Thursday - Jesus observes the Passover meal with His disciples. It is here that He institutes what we now know as The Lord's Supper. After observing this meal with His disciples, they head to the Garden of Gethsemane. There Jesus prays and is ultimately arrested and the events that lead to the cross are set in motion.

Friday - Jesus is run through a series of trials to determine His guilt. Though no guilt is established, He is crucified anyway. He is on the cross by 9:00 AM and has died by 3:00 PM.

Saturday – This day is somewhat silent. It was the Sabbath and Jesus' body was in the tomb. This is a good day for reflection as we consider all that Jesus has done for us.

Easter Sunday - This is of course, the day our Lord was resurrected. With His resurrection He defeated sin and death once and for all.

Throughout this week, take time to consider each day. Journey through this week in the presence of our Lord.


