We seem to have the virus under control, there are vaccines available (I understand opinions vary as it relates to this), and things are beginning to open up once again. Now is our chance to do some real reflection. Who do we want to be going forward? As a church? As an individual? We have the strangely unique opportunity to begin again.

As your pastoral staff, we have been giving a lot of thought to this. We have been thinking through our strengths and weaknesses. Whether you have grown up at Northside or have only joined in the last six months, this is your church. Part of being a member is to not only receive, but to invest. Yes, investing financially is important, but it is also important to invest your time and energy. I am looking with optimism to the days ahead. At Northside our tag line is, "Journey Together." I hope that is more than a simple phrase, I hope it is a commitment.


