Sunday	Celebration	Matt. 21:1-11 Mark 11:1-11 Luke 19:28-44 John 12:12-19	Why was the crowd so excited to see Jesus as He came into town?	Take a family walk, maintaining social distance, and identify the various palms that are growing in your neighborhood.
Monday	Correction	Matt 21:12-22 Mark 11:15-19 Luke 19:45-48	Why was Jesus so upset to see people selling things in the Temple?	Jesus said, "My house shall be called a house of prayer." Have a time of family prayer.
Tuesday	Instruction	Matt 21:23-2:51 Mark 11:20-13:37 Luke 20:1-21:36 John 12:20-38	Why do you think Jesus took so much time to teach His disciples about the things that were to come?	Using sidewalk chalk or a poster board, draw a picture of Jesus teaching on the Mount of Olives. Take a picture of your drawing and post it to social media with the hashtag #NBCEaster
Wednesday	Silence		What do you think the disciples and Jesus were doing on this day?	For an age appropriate amount of time, sit in silence and reflect on the question, "What does Easter mean to me?"
Thursday	Emotion	Matt 26:17-75 Mark 14:12-72 Luke 22:7-62 John 13:1-38	What do you think it would have felt like to be in that upper room with Jesus?	Thursday is the day that Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper. Have a time of Family Communion, discussing what each of the elements mean. Use what you have: bread, crackers, juice of any sort. Bonus points if you make your own "Unleavened Bread."
Friday	Agony	Matt 27:1-62 Mark 15:1-47 Luke 22:63-23:56 John 18:28-19:37	Why is Jesus' death on the cross so important?	If age appropriate, watch "The Passion of the Christ" together. If not, try to find an age appropriate movie related to the crucifixion of Christ.
Saturday	Uncertainty		What do you think you would have been feeling on this day if you were there?	Have a family discussion about the uncertainty of the times we live in and relate it to the uncertainty that Christ's disciples must have felt.
Sunday	Victory	Matt 28:1-13 Mark 16:1-14 Luke 24:1-49 John 20:1-23	Why is the resurrection of Jesus Christ so important?	Participate in as many of your traditional Easter family activities as possible.
