**We all, like sheep, went astray; we turned, each one, to his own way; yet Adonai laid on Messiah the guilt of all of us.
Therefore, I will assign Him a share with the great, He will divide the spoil with the mighty.**
Isaiah 53:6,12

We Praise God as Our Father: **Psalm 100:3-5** Know and fully recognize with gratitude that the Lord Himself is God; It is He who has made us, not we ourselves [and we are His]. *We are* His people and the sheep of His pasture. ⁴Enter His gates with a song of thanksgiving and His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, bless and praise His name. ⁵For the Lord is good; His mercy and lovingkindness are everlasting, His faithfulness [endures] to all generations. **Psalm 68:5-6** A father of the fatherless and judge and protector of the widows is God in His holy habitation. ⁶God makes a home for the lonely; He leads the prisoners into prosperity, only the stubborn and rebellious dwell in a parched land. **Psalm 118:28-29** You are my God, and I give thanks to You; [You are] my God, I extol You. ²⁹O give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; For His lovingkindness endures forever. **Malachi 2:10** Do we not all have one Father? Has not one God created us? Why do we deal treacherously with one another, profaning the covenant of our fathers [with God]?

We Ask and Listen: **Psalm 25:4,5** Let me know Your ways, O Lord; Teach me Your paths. ⁵Guide me in Your truth and teach me for You are the God of my salvation; For You [and only You] I wait [expectantly] all the day long. **Isaiah 40:31** But those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] will gain new strength and renew their power; They will lift up their wings [and rise up close to God] like eagles [rising toward the sun]; They will run and not become weary, they will walk and not grow tired. **Psalm 78:1-4** Listen, O my people, to my teaching; Incline your ears to the words of my mouth [and be willing to learn]. ²I will open my mouth in a parable [to instruct using examples]; I will utter dark and puzzling sayings of old [that contain important truth]—
³Which we have heard and known, and our fathers have told us. ⁴We will not hide them from their children but [we will] tell to the generation to come the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord and [tell of] His great might and power and the wonderful works that He has done. **1 John 4:7,8** Beloved, let us [unselfishly] love and seek the best for one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves [others] is born of God and knows God [through personal experience]. ⁸The one who does not love has not become acquainted with God [does not and never did know Him], for God is love. [He is the originator of love, and it is an enduring attribute of His nature.]

Our Response - Obedience: **Matthew 22:37** And Jesus replied to him, “‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ **Proverbs 3:5** Trust in and rely confidently on the Lord with all your heart and do not rely on your own insight or understanding. **Proverbs 23:22-25** Buy truth, and do not sell it; Get wisdom and instruction and understanding. ²⁴The father of the righteous will greatly rejoice and he who sires a wise child will have joy in him. ²⁵Let your father and your mother be glad and let her who gave birth to you rejoice [in your wise and godly choices]. **Ephesians 6:4** Children, obey your parents in the Lord [that is, accept their guidance and discipline as His representatives], for this is right [for obedience teaches wisdom and self-discipline]. ²Honor [esteem, value as precious] your father and your mother [and be respectful to them]—this is the first commandment with a promise—³so that it may be well with you, and that you may have a long life on the earth. ⁴Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger [do not exasperate them to the point of resentment with demands that are trivial or unreasonable or humiliating or abusive; nor by showing favoritism or indifference to any of them], but bring them up [tenderly, with lovingkindness] in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Our Blessings of Obedience: **Deut 28:1-15** “Now it shall be, if you diligently listen to and obey the voice of the Lord your God, being careful to do all of His commandments which I am commanding you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. ²All these blessings will come upon you and overtake you if you pay attention to the voice of the Lord your God.³“You will be blessed in the city, and you will be blessed in the field. **Psalms 1:1-2** Blessed [fortunate, prosperous, and favored by God] is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked [following their advice and example], nor stand in the path of sinners, nor sit [down to rest] in the seat of scoffers (ridiculers). ²But his delight is in the law of the Lord and on His law [His precepts and teachings] he [habitually] meditates day and night. **Philippians 4:4-6** Rejoice in the Lord always [delight, take pleasure in Him]; again I will say, rejoice! ⁵Let your gentle spirit [your graciousness, unselfishness, mercy, tolerance, and patience] be known to all people. The Lord is near. ⁶Do not be anxious or worried about anything, but in everything [every circumstance and situation] by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, continue to make your [specific] requests known to God. ⁷And the peace of God [that peace which reassures the heart, that peace] which transcends all understanding, [that peace which] stands guard over your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus [is yours].
