



Yakima Valley 24/7 Prayer Scripture Support for Prayer Topics September 2021

Incline your ear [to listen] and come to Me; Hear, so that your soul may live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, *According to the faithful mercies [promised and] shown to David. Isaiah 55:3*

Our Praise: **Psalm 146:1,2** Praise the Lord! (Hallelujah!) Praise the Lord, O my soul! ² While I live I will praise the Lord; I will sing praises to my God as long as I live. **Psalm 150:1,2** Praise the Lord! Praise God in His sanctuary; Praise Him in His mighty heavens. ² Praise Him for His mighty acts; Praise Him according to [the abundance of] His greatness. **Psalm 138:1-3** I will give You thanks with all my heart; I sing praises to You before the [pagan] gods. ² I will bow down [in worship] toward Your holy temple and give thanks to Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; for You have magnified Your word together with Your name. ³ On the day I called, You answered me; and You made me bold *and* confident with [renewed] strength in my life. **Revelation 4:8** And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, are full of eyes all over and within [underneath their wings]; and day and night they never stop saying, “Holy, holy, holy [is the] Lord God, the Almighty [the Omnipotent, the Ruler of all], who was and who is and who is to come [the unchanging, eternal God].”

His Will: **Ephesians 1:5-8** He predestined *and* lovingly planned for us to be adopted to Himself as [His own] children through Jesus Christ, in accordance with the kind intention *and* good pleasure of His will— ⁶ to the praise of His glorious grace *and* favor, which He so freely bestowed on us in the Beloved [His Son, Jesus Christ]. ⁷ In Him we have redemption [that is, our deliverance and salvation] through His blood, [which paid the penalty for our sin and resulted in] the forgiveness *and* complete pardon of our sin, in accordance with the riches of His grace ⁸ which He lavished on us. In all wisdom and understanding [with practical insight]. **Isaiah 55:6-9** Seek the Lord while He may be found; Call on Him [for salvation] while He is near. ⁷ Let the wicked leave (behind) his way and the unrighteous man his thoughts; And let him return to the Lord and He will have compassion (mercy) on him and to our God for He will abundantly pardon. ⁸ “For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways,” declares the Lord. ⁹ “For as the heavens are higher than the earth so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts *higher* than your thoughts.”

Our Identity: **Ephesians 1:3-4** Blessed *and* worthy of praise be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms in Christ, ⁴ just as [in His love] He chose us in Christ [actually selected us for Himself as His own] before the foundation of the world, so that we would be holy [that is, consecrated, set apart for Him, purpose-driven] and blameless in His sight. **Isaiah 43:1-3** But now, this is what the Lord, your Creator says, O Jacob and He who formed you, O Israel, “Do not fear, for I have redeemed you [from captivity]; I have called you by name; you are Mine! ² “When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they will not overwhelm you. When you walk through fire, you will not be scorched, nor will the flame burn you. ³ “For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior;

Our Petitions: Our families, churches, schools are in a spiritual drought, withering from a deficit of Your life-giving presence. Our police and first responders need You. We suffer from abuse, addictions, violence, diseases and divisions. We cry out to You, reaching upward for Heaven’s rain. **Psalm 40:1-3** I waited patiently *and* expectantly for the Lord; and He inclined to me and heard my cry. ² He brought me up out of a horrible pit [of tumult and of destruction], out of the miry clay and He set my feet upon a rock, steadying my footsteps *and* establishing my path. ³ He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God; Many will see and fear [with great reverence] and will trust confidently in the Lord. **Psalm 46:1-3** God is our refuge and strength [mighty and impenetrable], a very present *and* well-proved help in trouble. ² Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change and though the mountains be shaken *and* slip into the heart of the seas, ³ Though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its roaring.

His Invitation: **John 1:9-13** There it was—the true Light [the genuine, perfect, steadfast Light] which, coming into the world, enlightens everyone. ¹⁰ He (Christ) was in the world, and though the world was made through Him, the world did not recognize Him. ¹¹ He came to that which was His own [that which belonged to Him—His world, His creation, His possession], and those who were His own [people—the Jewish nation] did not receive *and* welcome Him. ¹² But to as many as did receive *and* welcome Him, He gave the right [the authority, the privilege] to become children of God, *that is*, to those who believe in (adhere to, trust in, and rely on) His name— ¹³ who were born, not of blood [natural conception], nor of the will of the flesh [physical impulse], nor of the will of man [that of a natural father], but of God [that is, a divine and supernatural birth—they are born of God—spiritually transformed, renewed, sanctified]. **1 Jn 5:1-4** Everyone who believes [with a deep, abiding trust in the fact] that Jesus is the Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed) is born of God [that is, reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, and set apart for His purpose], and everyone who loves the Father also loves ^athe *child* born of Him. ² By this we know [without any doubt] that we love the children of God: [expressing that love] when we love God and obey His commandments. ³ For the [true] love of God is this: that we *habitually* keep His commandments *and* remain focused on His precepts. And His commandments *and* His precepts are not difficult [to obey]. ⁴ For ^beveryone born of God is victorious *and* overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has conquered *and* overcome the world—our [continuing, persistent] faith [in Jesus the Son of God].
