Explanation of the Service and This Handout

Confession without humility is an exercise in futility. How can there be authentic contrition, a heartfelt appreciation for the kindness of God without a recognition that we need the freedom and forgiveness that comes only from God? Confession begins with an acknowledgement that something is not right with us. Confession admits that we are imperfect, that we've failed others, we've failed God, and we've failed ourselves too. Confession is an honest cry for help. We confess our personal failings, and we confess the failures of our community too. The beauty of our Christian faith is that honest confession brings genuine forgiveness. "If we confess our sins, He (God) is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness". 1 John 1:9

Responsive Prayer of Confession

Heavenly Father, forgive us individually and as a community of faith here at Grace. Forgive us for failing to speak up on behalf of the poor, the broken, the abused. the homeless when You have wanted us to speak. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us for overlooking the physical needs of those who have been abandoned, those suffering from mental illness, those who are hungry, those without home or family. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us as a church community for how we have treated each other, how we have neglected those who have entered the doors of this church, times when we have thought poorly of others, told, and passed on lies, when we have been untruthful, when we have judged others. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us for the times leaders and staff at Grace have harmed others, whether intentionally or unintentionally. Forgive us for times when the sacrifices of volunteers and staff, the involvement they have made in the ministry of our community, has not ended well but has instead caused pain and heartache. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us when we have adopted the divisive tone now so prevalent in the world around us, when we have seen, or been tempted to see others, because their beliefs are different than ours, as our enemies rather than as Your people, our friends. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us for allowing division rather than unity define our relationships here at Grace of Christ. Forgive us for allowing our preferences for a particular style of music, or our preference for a particular pastor, or our decision whether to wear mask or not to wear masks, to separate us from each other, think less kindly of each other, withhold our grace and our love. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us for allowing abuse to exist in your church here at Grace, and in our own relationships, in our own homes. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us for withholding forgiveness when You have so generously forgiven us. Forgive us for our unwillingness to offer grace to those who have offended us, those who are indebted to us, those who have betrayed us, those who have harmed us. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us for our hypocrisy, saying one thing and then doing the opposite. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us for the times we have neglected You, taken You for granted, used You for our own ends and purposes. Forgive us when we have placed our trust in anyone or anything other than You. Forgive us when our worship of You has been routine, hollow, and self-serving. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Heavenly Father, forgive us for our past sins, give us new life, fill us with Your Holy Spirit, inspire us to live our lives thankful for all You have done for us, all You have given us, help us to trust You more, seek you more, serve You more, love You more. *Father, In Your mercy please forgive us*

Responsive Assurance of Pardon

Psalm 51:1-3, 9-12

<u>Leader:</u> Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin! For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquities.

<u>All</u>: Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from your presence and take not your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and uphold me with a willing spirit.

Psalm 103:8-13

<u>Leader</u>: The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. He will not always chide, nor will he keep his anger forever. He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him;

<u>All</u>: As far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us. As a father shows compassion to his children, so the Lord shows compassion to those who fear him.

Romans 5:6-8

<u>Leader</u>: For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die

All: But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us

1 John 1:8-10

Leader: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

<u>All</u>: If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.
