


# **Towel DRYve**

#### Frederick Lee Treadway

#### August 26, 1933 - December 3, 2020

Son of Henry Mangum Treadway, Sr. and Lula Jane Hunt Treadway, "Fred" and his twin sister were the youngest of the couple's nine children. They were born in the Anson County, NC community of Polkton. In early 1934 their father's job with Southern Railway brought the family to Charlotte, NC where they settled. They first became affiliated with First Baptist Church when it was located on North Tryon Street. Later they became members of Whiting Avenue Baptist Church in North Charlotte.

Fred was educated at Bethune Elementary School on Graham Street and graduated from Harry P. Harding High School with the Class of 1953. Upon graduation he became employed with Southern Bell Telephone Company in Charlotte. He entered the United States Army in 1954 and served until 1956. After his discharge, he returned to Southern Bell, which later became known as Bell South, working in Installation and Repair. After 42 years of service, he retired in 1995. Fred's favorite pastimes were eating, mowing grass, being outdoors and loving his dog, Charlie.

Fred and the former Lois Irene Honeycutt were united in Holy Matrimony on May 31, 1957 at Whiting Avenue Baptist Church. She is a native of Caldwell County, NC, daughter of William George Honeycutt and Stella Vee McCrary Honeycutt. Fred and Lois were formerly members of Mallard Creek Presbyterian Church in Charlotte, then Pitts Baptist Church in Concord and on December 11, 2005 became members of University Hills Baptist Church. Here at UHBC they were active in the Lewis Walker Sunday School Class. They returned their memberships to Mallard Creek Presbyterian Church three years ago and were members of the Robinson Sunday School Class there until his health began to fail.

Frederick Lee Treadway passed away peacefully at 3:40 a.m. on Thursday, December 3, 2020 in the comfort of his home with his wife and daughter at his side. He had suffered the past two years from complications related to two broken hips and died at the age of 87.

Fred was preceded in death by his father who died at age 85 on December 27, 1970 and his mother who died at age 78 on November 18, 1971. Also preceding in death were his five older brothers: Herbert Hoover Treadway who died June 7, 1935, age 4 years, Joseph Arthur Treadway who died June 15, 1952 at age 25, Robert Lee "Bob" Treadway who died September 30, 1977 at age 58, Henry Mangum Treadway, Jr. who died January 8, 2001, age 75, and Edwin Nelson "Ed" Treadway who died August 15, 2008 at 87 years of age.

Fred is survived by his wife of 63 years, Lois; their three children, Jeffrey Lee Treadway and wife, Lenita Rhee Frazier Treadway of Charlotte, Frederick Alan Treadway of Concord, NC, and Janet Dawn Treadway Tate and husband, Steven Ellis Tate of near Mint Hill, NC.

He is also survived by his three sisters, all of Charlotte, including his twin, Frances Leigh Treadway Hilton (also a former UHBC member), Melba Louise Treadway Fitzgerald Bryson, age 104, and Mildred Elizabeth Treadway Morrison, 97, and her 99-year-old husband, Fred L. Morrison. Other survivors include a sister-in-law and her husband of Hudson, NC,

Vera Helen Honeycutt Robbins and Kenneth Robbins, and several nieces and nephews.

Graveside services were held for Fred at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, December 7, 2020 at Gethsemane Memorial Gardens in Charlotte. Officiating at the rites were the co-pastors at Mallard Creek Presbyterian Church, Reverends Robert "Rob" Miller Watkins and Alison Messick Watkins.
