

"Pat", as she was affectionately known by family and friends, will be remembered in a memorial service held at University Hills Baptist Church on Saturday, June 19, 2021. A visitation in the Gathering Place will begin at 11 a.m. followed by the service in the sanctuary at 1 p.m. conducted by UHBC pastor, Reverend Richard Allen "Bo" Riley, Jr.

She was born in Charlotte (Mecklenburg County), NC and lived all of her life there until moving in May 2020 to Sarasota, FL to live near her daughter and family. Her parents were Charles Edwin "Charlie" Thornburg and Edith Marie James Thornburg, and she was the fourth and last surviving of their five daughters.

Pat was educated in the Charlotte schools and graduated from Charlotte Technical High School with the Class of 1952.

For 30 plus years, she was employed as bookkeeper with Winfield Supply, Inc. on North Tryon Street in Charlotte, retiring around 1995. She enjoyed times spent with her family, good food, traveling, being involved in many church activities and bowling. She was a longtime member of a Woman's Bowling League and was inducted into the Charlotte Woman's Bowling Hall of Fame. A former member of Green Memorial Baptist Church in north Charlotte, she was married there September 17, 1955 to James Lewis Sullivan.Lewis was also a Mecklenburg County native, youngest of five children born to James Carl Sullivan and Nell Eugenia Comer Sullivan. He and Pat enjoyed 62 years together before his passing February 6, 2018 at age 84.

The Sullivans were formerly longtime members of Grace Baptist Church in Charlotte where both were active in numerous leadership positions. Pat sang in the church choir, served as Sunday School Director, taught Acteens and was active in the Woman's Missionary Union. They then joined Providence Baptist Church in Harrisburg, and on October 28, 2001 became members of University Hills Baptist Church. At UHBC they were active members of the Lewis Walker Sunday School Class and the Spice of Life Senior Adults Group. Pat was a member of the Senior Adults Choir. The Sullivans moved their memberships to Hickory Grove Baptist Church November 20, 2017. Patricia Ann "Pat" Thornburg Sullivan passed away at 1:15 p.m. on Saturday, March 13, 2021 at the Tidewll Hospice House in Venice, FL. She had suffered a stroke in February and then fell and broke her hip. She died at the age of 87 years.

Preceding her in death, in addition to her husband Lewis, was her mother who died October 13, 1956 at age 61, her father, who died April 19, 1967 at age 77. Also preceding in death were her four sisters: Ezelle Harriet Thornburg Sherrill who died March 4, 2003, age 82, Dora Jacqueline Thornburg Biddy who died March 13, 2007, age 81, Jane Marie Thornburg Mull who died September 12, 2008, age 80 and Gloria Charleen Thornburg Johnson who died March 22, 2017, age 80.

Survivors include her son, James Carl Sullivan of Charlotte, daughter and son-in-law, Tonda Lee Sullivan Horne and John Eric Horne, Sr. of Sarasota; daughter-in-law, Joyce Deane Behling Sullivan of Gastonia, NC; five grandchildren: Amber Marie Sullivan Jones and husband, Ronald Richard Jones, Jr. of Detroit, MI, Natalie Nicole Sullivan Matthews and husband, Scott Woodrow Matthews of Belmont, NC, David Keith Sullivan of Gastonia, Savannah Grace Horne and John Eric Horne, Jr. both of Sarasota, FL; three great-grandchildren: Aiden James Sullivan, Olivia Skye Jones and Connor Woodrow Matthews; six nieces, seven nephews and their families.

Continue to remember Sharon in prayer as she is currently homebound undergoing in-home therapy as she recovers from mobility issues.




