In March we were able to make our first ministry trip in over a year to a mission conference being held at Rio Grande Bible College near McAllen, Texas. This is a school of 150 Hispanic students from Mexico to Chile. Barry spoke twice and we had non-stop meetings and impromptu conversations, all in Spanish, with students. The school is very focused on training for ministry and we're trusting God that He will call some of them to join SEND in global outreach.

In Barry's mission leadership role, his day-to-day involves planning, mentoring, and meetings. The month of May also has him teaching two courses. The first is with a Bible institute in Chile. This (Spanish) course is on Animism and Folk Religion and meets 2X p/week on Zoom. **Please pray** for wisdom and clarity as Barry prepares to teach, and that the students will be motivated toward taking the Gospel to the unreached.

Barry has also been invited to teach a missions training course to Word of Life college students in Hungary, May 24-29 and also to speak at their graduation. As of this writing, it is still a toss up whether he will be able to do this in person or via Zoom. Either way, **please pray** that above all the students would be touched by the fact that God is moving in the world to bring the nations to Himself and that they would consider how they might engage in global ministry. Also **please pray** for clarity and focus as the content is given through a translator.
