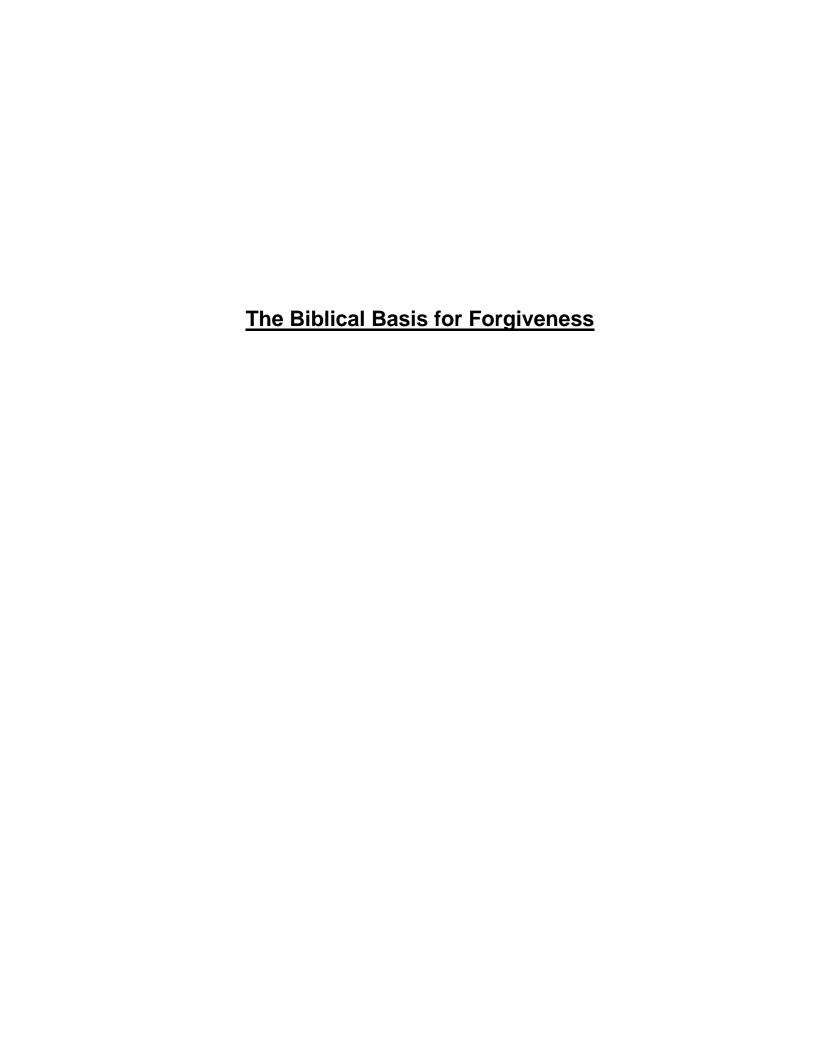
The Road Map

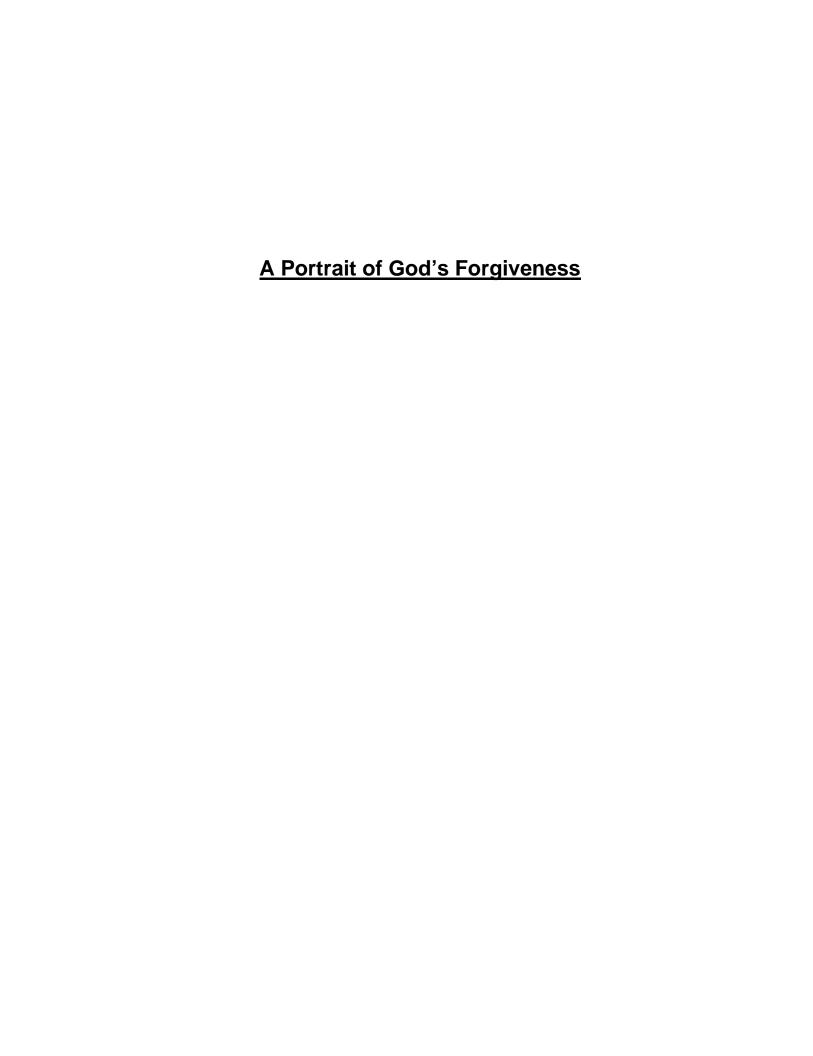
