## Broken People

Focus on the failure of others

Overwhelmed with a sense of their own spiritual need

Self-righteous; have a critical, fault-finding spirit; look at own life/faults through a Compassionate; forgiving; look for the best telescope but at others with a microscope in others

Look down on others Esteem all others better than self

Independent/self-sufficient spirit Dependant spirit; recognize need for others

Surrender control

Maintain control; must be their way

Willing to yield the right to be right

Have to prove they are right

Motivated to serve others

Sense of unworthiness; thrilled to be used at Driven to be recognized/appreciated all; eager for others to get credit

Wounded when others are promoted and Rejoice when others are lifted up they are overlooked

"The ministry is privileged to have me"

Think of what they can do for God Know that they have nothing to offer to God

Feel confident in how much they know Humbled by how much they have to learn

Self-conscious Not concerned with self at all

Keep people at arm's length Risk getting close to others; willing to take

the risk of loving intimately

Quick to blame others Accept personal responsibility – can see

where they are wrong

Unapproachable "Easy to be entreated"

Defensive when criticized Receive criticism with a humble, open heart

Concerned with being "respectable"

Concerned with being real

Concerned about what others think All that matters is what God knows Die to own reputation Work to maintain image/protect reputation Willing to be open and transparent with Find it difficult to share their spiritual needs others with others Willing to be exposed (once broken, they Want to be sure nobody finds out about don't care who knows - nothing to lose) their sin Quick to admit failure and seek forgiveness Have a hard time saying, "I was wrong; will you please forgive me?" Deal in specifics When confessing sin, deal in generalities Grieve over the cause or root of their sins Concerned about the consequences of their sins Remorseful over their sin - got Repentant over sin (forsake it) caught/found out Take the initiative to be reconciled; see if When there is a misunderstanding or conflict, wait for the other to come and ask they can get to the cross first! for forgiveness Compare themselves to the holiness of God Compare themselves with others and feel and feel desperate need for mercy deserving of honor Continual heart attitude of repentance Don't think they have anything to repent of Continually sense their need for a fresh Don't think they nee revival (think everybody else does) infilling of the Holy Spirit
