PALM TO EASTER SUNDAY

PALM SUNDAY

- Matthew 21:12-17, Jesus comes on a donkey. A great song for this is Hosanna by Hillsong. Memory verse is Mark 11:9! Make a donkey face on a paper bag, and there you go! A donkey hand puppet.

MONDAY

- Mark 11: 12-17, Jesus clears the temple. Memory verse is Mark 11:17/Isaiah 56:7. Make time to pray together. Take a mason jar, decorate it. Then write prayer requests of praises on popsicle sticks to place in your prayer jars!

TUESDAY

- Luke 19:47-48, Jesus teaches at the temple. A great song to listen to for this is The Word by Amy Grant. Memory verse is Psalm 119:105. Make a scroll out of two popsicle sticks and paper! Symbolizing that Jesus loves God's word!

WEDNESDAY

- John 13:1-18, Jesus washes the disciple's feet. Memory verse is Mark 10:45. Spend time explaining to your children why Jesus washed their feet. Now you! Wash each other's feet!

THURSDAY

- Mark 14:17-26, 32-35, 43-50, Luke 22:14-53, Jesus' last supper with the disciples. Memory verse is Luke 22:19. Spend time explaining to your kiddos what it means and how important it is to remember what Jesus did for us!

FRIDAY

- Mark 15:16-39, Luke 23:26-49, The Crucifixion. Memory verse is Luke 23:34. Make a resurrection garden. Either grab a little plant and add crosses to it, make one outside or whatever! Get creative! See next page for links.



SATURDAY

- Mark 15: 42-47, Luke 23: 50-56, Jesus was laid in the tomb. The memory verse is Mark 15:46. Make resurrection rolls!! See next page to see recipe.

SUNDAY

- Luke 24: 1-12, Jesus is ALIVE! A great worship song is Christ is Alive by Matt Maher. Memory verse is Luke 24:6. Eat the resurrection rolls you made yesterday! Roll the stone away from your resurrection rolls!! Talk about what this all means with your kids. REJOICE!! the King is alive!



HOW TO BAKE

Resurrection Rolls

THE STORY & INSTRUCTIONS



Jesus is God's son who was sent to earth to pay the price for our sins. He never sinned. The white of the marshmallow represents the purity and sin-free nature of Christ.

After Jesus dies, his body was prepared for burial. His friends then prepared his body with oil and spices. Dip the marshmallow in butter, than in sugar and cinnamon.

Jesus was wrapped in linen and placed in a tomb with a large stone rolled in front. Wrap the marshmallow in a triangle of dough, covering it completely with dough like a ball or a "rock"

Complete that process for all 16 triangles and marshmallows. Place in the oven for 10-12 minutes

Preheat oven to 350
degrees

2 Cans of Crescent
rolls

16 large marshmallows

1/2 C melted butter

1/4 C granulated sugar

2 TBSP cinnamon

Allow rolls to cool. Say after 3 days, his friends went to visit the tomb, but the tomb was rolled away! Reveal that when you cut the roll, the marshmallow has disappeared!

Remind your kids that God's love for us is sweet, just like the rolls, but even better!
