Raising Support

Raising support within the Calvary Corvallis church body is generally defined as solicitation of financial support for the purpose of missions (either long-term or short-term) by communicating to the body as a whole, or in part, through means approved by the Missions Team and church leadership. Examples of this are: Open invitation meetings to church members, whether held at church or in private homes; announcements in the church bulletin or speaking before the church; any presentation on church property displaying or discussing the need for support.

- Any “raising of support” as defined above must be approved through the Missionary Application process.
- After an applicant meets with the missions team, a recommendation will be provided to the Senior Leadership team of Calvary Corvallis for final approval.
- Support raising for missions is limited to regular Calvary Corvallis attenders.
- Calvary Corvallis specifically prohibits using the church directory for solicitation of funds and asks that support come through established relationships, appeals to the body through the leadership of the church, including Missions Café, or specific referrals from these established relationships.
