Luke - To Make Jesus Known April 26, 2020

What new interests or hobbies are you pursuing this time? Do you see this time as a season of inconvenience or one of opportunity?

Read Luke 24:50-53 and think about all we have explored of Jesus' life in this Gospel. What stands out to you? What did you discover about Jesus that you didn't know before?

Luke 24:50-53 is a shortened account of what we see in Acts 1:1-11. Read Acts 1:1-11 and dig into the following questions:

- What did Jesus do in the forty days he was with his disciples between his resurrection and his ascension?
- Why did the disciples ask Jesus about the restoration of the kingdom of Israel?
- Jesus redirected the disciples' question. What did Jesus promise? What did Jesus call them to be and do?

We know about Jesus because the disciples did not stand gawking (Acts 1:11). They made Jesus known by being witnesses across their world. What opportunities do you see, even in this season, to make Jesus known?
