

The Apostles' Creed:

I Believe in God the Father Almighty

Start this time by reciting the Apostles' Creed. What is the purpose of a creed? What purpose can a creed serve in your walk with God?

Let us look at the responses of people in Scripture when God Almighty appeared in all His power, majesty and holiness. Look at the following examples (just a few of them!):

1. Read Genesis 17:1-13a. What did God say about Himself? What was Abraham's reaction?
2. Read Job 40:1-5. What did God say about Himself? What was Job's response?
3. Read Isaiah 6:1-5. What did the vision reveal about God? What was Isaiah's reaction to what he witnessed.

After reading a few samples of people's reactions to God, think about your response. How can your life reflect your belief in God Almighty?

As one pastor put it, "God is infinitely powerful and intensely personal." God calls us into relationship with Him. Read what Paul wrote in Galatians 4:4-7.

1. What did God do to reconcile the relationship with His people?
2. Who are we because of what God did for us?
3. How does my relationship with God affect what I do and say?
