

Ro 1:12	Let us encourage each other's faith
Ro 12:10	Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.
Ro 12:16	Live in harmony with one another . Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight.
Ro 13:8	Owe no one anything, except to love each other , for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law.
Ro 14:13	Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.
Ro 14:19	So then let us pursue what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding.
Ro 15:5	May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in harmony with one another , in accord with Christ Jesus,
Ro 15:7	Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.
2 Co 7:1	Since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit, bringing holiness to completion in the fear of God.
2 Co 13:11	Finally, brothers, rejoice. Aim for restoration, comfort one another , agree with one another , live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.
Ga 5:13	For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another .
Ga 5:15	But if you bite and devour one another , watch out that you are not consumed by one another .
Ga 5:25	If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit.
Ga 5:26	Let us not become conceited, provoking one another , envying one another .
Ga 6:2	Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.
Ga 6:9	And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.
Ga 6:10	So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.
Eph 4:2	bearing with one another in love,
Eph 4:32	Be kind to one another , tenderhearted, forgiving one another , as God in Christ forgave you.
Eph 5:21	submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.
Col 3:9	Do not lie to one another , seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices

Col 3:13	bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other ; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.
Col 3:16	Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
1 Th 3:12	and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you,
1 Th 4:9	Now concerning brotherly love you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love one another ,
1 Th 4:18	Therefore encourage one another with these words.
1 Th 5:6	So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober.
1 Th 5:8	But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation.
1 Th 5:11	Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.
1 Th 5:15	See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone.
2 Th 1:3	We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing.
Heb 3:13	But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called “today,” that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.
Heb 4:14	Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.
Heb 4:16	Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
Heb 6:1	Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,
Heb 10:22	let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
Heb 10:23	Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.
Heb 10:24	And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,
Heb 10:25	Let us not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another , and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

Heb 12:1	Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,
Heb 12:28	Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe,
Jas 4:11	Do not speak evil against one another , brothers. The one who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks evil against the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge.
Jas 5:9	Do not grumble against one another , brothers, so that you may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing at the door.
Jas 5:16	Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another , that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.
1 Pe 1:22	Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart,
1 Pe 4:8	Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.
1 Pe 4:9	Show hospitality to one another without grumbling.
1 Pe 4:10	As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another , as good stewards of God's varied grace:
1 Pe 5:5	Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another , for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
1 Jn 1:7	But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another , and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.
1 Jn 3:11	For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another .
1 Jn 3:18	Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.
1 Jn 3:23	And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another , just as he has commanded us.
1 Jn 4:7	Beloved, let us love one another , for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God.
1 Jn 4:11	Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another .
1 Jn 4:12	No one has ever seen God; if we love one another , God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.
2 Jn 5	And now I ask you, dear lady—not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning—that we love one another .
