Community Church Unshakeable - Hebrews 4:14-5:10 February 27, 2022

- 1. Start your time by reviewing what you have studied so far in the book of Hebrews. What has been encouraging? What has been challenging? What have you learned about Jesus?
- 2. Read Hebrews 4:14–16 and the find the challenges (Here's a hint: they begin with "let us."). What is the author calling followers of Jesus to do?
- 3. Verse 15 is the key verse. We can hold fast and we can draw near with confidence because of who Jesus is and what he endured. What does this verse tell us about Jesus?
- 4. The word "sympathy" tells us that Jesus is actively aware and concerned for the struggles his people encounter. His heart is moved with compassion to action. When you think of the difficulties and struggles you face, how do you respond to this news about Jesus' heart for you?
- 5. What need might you be experiencing now? Share that need with someone and together, go before God in prayer knowing that Jesus is also interceding for you.
