2. Read Habakkuk 1:1-4. What is Habakkuk's complaint? Have you ever cried out to God? What was Habakkuk wanting God to do? Read Habakkuk 3:1-2 for insight.
3. Read Habakkuk 1:5-11. What was God's answer to Habakkuk's complaint?
4. Why was Habakkuk upset with God's answer? Read Habakkuk 1:12-13.
5. The key verse for the book of Habakkuk is 2:4. What does this verse mean? Read Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11, and Hebrews 10:38.
6. The name Habakkuk means "wrestler" and "embracer." How do you see these two realities in this book?
7. Read Habakkuk 3:17-19. What stands out to you in these verses? In what ways are you challenged by these verses?
8. Our circumstances can change. Make a list of all the things that have changed in your life over the last few months.
9. What is one thing that hasn't changed?
10. What does it mean for you to "walk by faith" today?
