- 1) Describe a time in your life where you struggled with uncertainty. How did you feel? What were the circumstances? What was the outcome? How do you overcome that uncertainty?
- 2) In the last week of Jesus' life His disciples most likely struggled with uncertainty. What are some ways that they would have experienced uncertainty during that last week of Jesus' life? Where did they find hope in the midst of their uncertainty?
- 3) Read Matthew 28:18-20 and Acts 1:8. What do these verses tell you about one of the keys to Christianity?
- 4) Read Acts 17:1-4. Why do you think Paul passes through Amphipolis and Apollonia and goes to Thessalonica?
- 5) How long was Paul in Thessalonica? What words describe what Paul did in Thessalonica? How did the crowds respond?
- 6) Read Acts 17:5-9. What happens in these verses?
- 7) Why do these religious leaders respond this way? Why did they accuse Paul of "turning the world upside down"?
- 8) Why do you think Paul left Thessalonica?
- 9) Paul came to Thessalonica with a message of Hope and that message changed people's lives. Who are the people in your sphere of influence that need that hope?
- 10) Romans 10:15 says "how beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news." Make a list of people who need to hear the life-changing message of the gospel and pray over that list together as a group.
