- 5) Do you agree with this statement: "practice makes perfect"? Why or why not?
- 6) Read 1 Thessalonians 5:16-22. Paul bullet points a list of things that Christians should practice. Which ones are easier for you? Which ones are harder?
- 7) Make a list of things that you want to "practice" more of in your walk with the Lord. Share them with your group to keep you accountable.
