- 5. Read Micah 3:12 and Micah 4:1. Describe the contrast between these 2 verses. What does this tell you about God?
- 6. Read Micah 5:1-5a. What stands out to you in these verses? What promise do you see in this passage?
- 7. Read Micah 6:8. What do these 3 things mean for us today? What does it look like to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with God?
- 8. Read Micah 7:18-20. What do these final words of Micah mean to you? How do they encourage you today?
