From Rubble to Redemption: Zechariah

1. Take a moment and review our series “Rubble to Redemption.” What has challenged you from the Minor Prophets we have already explored?
2. Read Zechariah 1:1-6. What is the core message that Zechariah shares with the people from the LORD of Hosts?
3. In verse 3 God reveals that He is “the LORD of Hosts.” This is repeated 53 times throughout this book. What is God saying about who He is? How are the people to respond to the LORD? How are we?
4. Who is Zechariah speaking of in Zechariah 9:9, 13:7 and 12:10?
5. The book of Zechariah is filled with visions that are hard to understand (Suggestion: watch the Bible Project video for one interpretation of how they fit together). Zechariah is clear about “that day” referring to the Day of the LORD. What similarities do you see between Zechariah 14:6-9 and Revelation 21:22-26?
6. Zechariah is quoted and referenced in the New Testament more times than any other Old Testament book except for the Psalms. Compare Zechariah 1:3 and James 4:8. What is the message of these verses? What does that look like in your life?
