EQUIPPING PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Equipping Program is a one-year discipleship program that immerses participants in Scripture's grand narrative. The program is constructed upon four pillars: Christian Story, Christian Doctrine, Christian Worldview, and Christian Formation. By weaving together these four pillars into a holistic approach to discipleship, men and women have the opportunity to grow in their love for God, Scripture, and His mission. The class meets once a week over a traditional academic calendar (nine months.) Class sessions consist of lecture, cohort discussion, and Q & A.

All major historical-redemptive events in salvation history point to and are fulfilled in the person and work of Jesus Christ.



CHRISTIAN DOCTRINE

All Christian theology is rooted in Scripture and is the foundation to worshipping the one true God.



CHRISTIAN WORLDVIEW

The Christian worldview is different from all others. Understanding the differences is essential for Christians to live counter-culturally with a heart to reach the lost.



CHRISTIAN FORMATION

Christian Story and Doctrine shape and form God's people into servants, worshippers, and disciple-makers who are fluent in gospel-responsive living.
