We are continuing our sermon series on the letters to the churches in Revelation! The Book of Revelation was told by Jesus to the apostle John who wrote it down. Revelation is a book that reveals true things that are to come. A lot of the books of the Bible that we read are stories of God's people or Jesus. Revelation is a book written about what is to come that only God knows fully. As a church, we are focusing on the letters to the churches at the beginning of Revelation. Revelation is a book that reminds us that God has had a plan from the very beginning to make all things new! Jesus will come again and when He does, He won't come as a baby. He will come as a ruling king! The King that will restore all things.

Key Point: The Bible is God's True Word

Repeat the Key Point several times together as a family. Have everyone pick one way to say the Key Point (rap it, in an accent, quietly, loudly, in an accent, etc.)

Read & Discuss:

As a family, open your Bibles to **Revelation 2:18-29** and read it out loud. Help everyone in the family find the verse and read along.

- 1. What Foundational Truth or Attribute of God did you think of when you read this? Foundational Truth: Jesus Came to Save Sinners Attribute of God: Holy, Righteous, Judge
- 2. When addressing the church at Thyatira, Jesus commends them for what five things found in verse 19?
 - Their works, love, faith, service and patient endurance.
- 3. Jesus then says they have been allowing a false teacher to convince the church of things that are against what God says is best. Why do you think Jesus is telling the church to worship God and Him alone?
 - God alone is worthy of worship! When people or things tell us anything different than that, then we should run from them.
- 4. In verse 27, Jesus says that He has received authority from the Father. He also said this before He went back to heaven to be with the Father after He rose again. Why is this important?
 - Because Jesus is the Son of God- He has authority to say these things, because He is God.
- 5. What truth did we learn about God today and what can we praise Him for?


