

Girls and guys will each have separate sleeping rooms on different floors of the building. We'll be sleeping on floors, so bring an air mattress, cot, or something similar. Showers will be in the evening off-site.

Travel

This trip will include transportation around the Freeport area. We will be taking every precaution to ensure that the vehicles we will take will be roadworthy. Encounter Packing List

- Bible and pen
- Bedding
 - We're on the floor, so bring an air mattress, cot, or sleeping bag

- Toiletries

 - Medication (let Alex know what you're brining)
 - Towel, washcloth
 - shower caddy (showers are off-site)
- Clothes for 6 days
 - Bring clothes that can get paint/dirty
 - During all work projects, we'll require all shirts to have sleeves (no tank tops), and cover the stomach, and shorts that rise no higher than an inch above the knee
 - Sturdy work shores
 - 1 pair work gloves
 - Swimsuit (if you want to wear it under your clothes during car wash)
- Sun stuff
 - Sunscreen, sunglasses, water bottle
- o Good attitude and desire to learn
